#### **Architecture Committee— The orderly development of Oak Ridge**

When the developer subdivided the 400+ acres of Oak Ridge I, II and III, he created the "DECLARATION OF COVENANTS, RE-STRICTIONS AND OBLIGATIONS FOR THE ORDERLY DEVELOP-MENT OF OAK RIDGE SUBDIVISION". This long title is more commonly called Covenants and Restrictions

Your purchase closing on your property provided you (or should have) a copy of this document as part of the process. You can find a scanned copy of the document on the web site:

The Bylaws of the Association call for the creation of an Architecture Committee, in support of item 2, Architectural control, of the Covenants and Restrictions, when a resident choses to enhance their property.

Before you seek a Pasco County permit and start construction, a quick trip to the Architecture committee will prevent legal complications for all concerned.

The committee has the responsibility to review and approve or disapprove a resident's request within 30 days of submittal. The members of the committee are made up of Oak Ridge homeowners such as yourself.

The committee received it first request on February 2, 2012 and


The third method is to personally hand a check to the Treasurer, Julie Rosin at the meeting.
