Thank you for your letter dated February 24, 2014, which we received March 14, 2014. I offer the following information, in response to your inquiry:

The County made application to the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) on March 15, 2013, for drainage improvements in the Duck Slough watershed. The application was reviewed under the SWFWMD rules, and, in order to obtain a permit from SWFWMD, the rules required that the County demonstrate that no adverse impact would occur to downstream properties. The SWFWMD determined that the application met the conditions for issuance of a permit, and subsequently issued Permit No. 43034034.001 on December 13, 2013.

The County has added you to the notification group for the Duck Slough/Thousand Oaks/Trinity Oaks Problem Solving Task Force. In addition to the County, the SWFWMD has an electronic notification system to notify interested parties of permit updates. In order to ensure that you are notified of any proposed modifications to the permit, it is suggested that a representative from the Oakridge Homeowner's Association register with the SWFWMD system. The registration is available at: <http://www18.swfwmd.state.fl.us/support/notification/NotificationHome.aspx>. Once at that site you will need to register, and then you will be able to request notification for an area, or information on a specific permit.
